Summary of Duties and Responsibilities

The Reservation Disaster Assistance Program Crew Supervisor will be responsible for performing all tasks assigned to the Reservation Disaster Assistance Crew Members as well as ensuring all workers are performing as required and reporting progress to the Site Supervisor twice daily.

The Disaster Assistant Crew Supervisor is responsible for working alongside the other crew members in clearing damaged tribal lands; cutting and removal of trees, roots and debris; clearing irrigation ditches; culverts, roadsides, erosion bank stabilization; and the general cleanup of damaged/affected areas on the tribal land. The Crew Supervisor is responsible for the day-to-day operation of this crew and making sure that projects are completed in a timely, professional manner. The Supervisor is also responsible for the submission of daily logs, employee time sheets, daily project progress reports, safety meeting logs, equipment in and out logs, vehicle operation logs, vehicle maintenance logs, and any other report that may be necessary for the safe operation of this crew.
