 - In 2021 Equal Distribution grant will not be offering because of revenues down from casino closures.
 - TNGF budget is flexible if cost is allowable. Only grocery store gift cards (not Walmart or other gift cards) It was budget \$350.00 only 1 per household, under 1-roof. The estimate is 120 QVIR households.
 - A signed application form is an agreement from tribal members in lieu of receipts.
 - FEMA grant that require match is allowable (This cost was not budgeted in TNGF)
