

# **Anav Tribal Health Clinic Quartz Valley Indian Reservation**

## **Request for Proposals**

**Proposal Deadline: Friday, September 28, 2018**

**The Quartz Valley Indian Reservation / Anav Tribal Health Clinic (QVIR/ATHC) requests proposals by qualified consultants to provide Technical Assistance to QVIR/ATHC the SAMHSA funded Youth and Family Tree project.**

Consultant services to be performed for a period of five years beginning approximately September 30, 2018. The Consultant should have relevant experience providing Technical Assistance on federally funded programs addressing mental and substance use disorders, suicide prevention, and mental health promotion using the System of Care Framework.

In close collaboration with the project staff and in partnership with the Quartz Valley Indian Reservation Community:

- a. Provide training and technical assistance on mental and substance abuse disorders, and mental health promotion.
- b. Assist in the development of comprehensive health care program strategies to prevent and reduce alcoholism, addiction, and alcohol and substance abuse in the youth & transitional age (See RFA).
- c. Advise the Tribe in identifying and coordinating existing resources and services to support and help sustain culturally relevant, community driven, evidence-based, treatment and approaches.
- d. Advise program staff and Tribal community in implementing wraparound services in a family-centered, team planning process.
- e. Develop a technical assistance plan for the duration of the project period.

### **Required Experience**

Demonstrated experience and expertise in providing technical assistance with similar grant projects.

Technical Assistance Consultant, or Consulting Firm, that have provided successful training and technical assistance for Tribes may receive priority.

Indian Preference: In accordance with CFR 25, Part 276 and in accordance with Title VII of the Civil Rights Act, Section 701(b) and 703(i), qualified American Indian Consultant candidates may have selection preference.

Responses to this RFP should include the following:

1. A statement of qualifications
2. Descriptions of similar work previously completed
3. Proposed cost with detailed cost breakdown

Responses must be received by September 28, 2018.
